Purpose

To plan, develop, implement and evaluate professional education programs, symposiums and seminars for faith community nurses in the Greater Twin Cities.

Key Responsibilities

- Develop an annual calendar of at least four (4) professional faith community nursing symposiums valued at a minimum of 3.5 CEUs
- Assure symposium topics include an emphasis on intentional spiritual care and are responsive to needs and interests identified by FCNs
- Identify and secure speakers with expertise in their selected topics
- Promote symposiums via website, email and regular mail; work with the Marketing Committee to identify additional promotional opportunities
- Assist with set up and clean up the day of the symposium
- Assure Program Partners and Program Sponsors are greeted, assisted to their display table and thanked/acknowledged for their participation
- Evaluate each symposium and use the resulting data in planning future events

Qualifications

Eligible candidates must be:

- A faith community nurse.
- Experienced and interested in continuing nursing education

Results

Committee Chair will share annual calendar of symposiums and report results of each symposium, including total attendance, participant rating of event, feedback re: speaker, etc. and plans for future symposiums.

Length of Appointment and Time Commitment

- Committee members will serve one-year terms
- Committee members must attend committee meetings, 1.5-2 hours in length, that are held 4-5 times per year.
- Committee members are required to register for and attend the 4 FCNN Continuing Education Symposiums each year.
