

Foundations of Faith Community Nursing Course

New *virtual* course offered by the
Faith Community Nurse Network of the Greater Twin Cities

Course Description: This course is required as preparation for RNs seeking to practice as Faith Community Nurses. It is based on the curriculum developed through the Westberg Institute for Faith Community Nursing which is owned by Spiritual Care Association, New York, New York.

We have updated and enhanced this course to address how Covid-19 has impacted FCN practice and have included information to help FCNs serve the needs of persons who have experienced psychological and/or spiritual trauma.

This offering is designed to meet the Minnesota Board of Nursing continuing education requirements of 38 contact hours. Each participant should determine whether the course meets the requirements for continuing education by their licensing organization.

Course Content: Our virtual classes plus four one-hour self-learning modules include these topics: ***Beginning Your Ministry; Prayer; Spiritual Care; Health Promotion; Legal and Ethical Issues; Documentation; Grief and Loss; Advocacy; Behavioral Health; Assessment; Transitional Care and several others.***

Course Methods: Our faculty of six advanced degreed RNs and FCNs use a variety of learning methods to encourage interaction and involvement of our students. Because faculty are practicing FCNs, they share real-life situations and experiences. The mentoring session is designed to help answer questions once you've started your practice.

Faith Community Nursing (sometimes called Parish Nursing) is a specialized practice of professional nursing that focuses on the intentional care of the spirit as well as the promotion of whole-person health and the prevention of illness (*Faith Community Nursing Scope and Standards of Practice: 3rd Edition*). FCNs are of all faiths and practice in many different settings

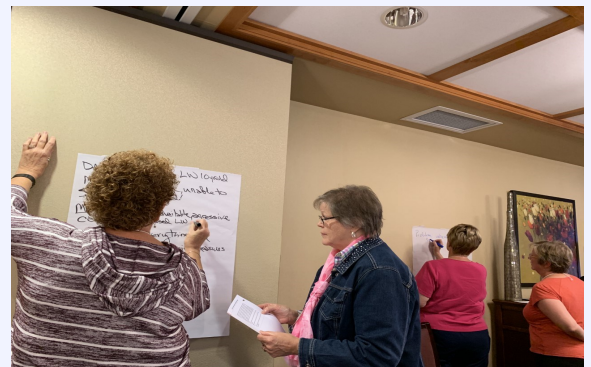
